




# ANNAPOORNA The Gift Of Nutrition




#### Gosaba, West Bengal August 6th




#### Jamshedpur, Jharkhand August 16th




## Eradicating Hunger in India In Conversation with Sri Anand Kadali






**7500** Reusable Masks for Truck Drivers










