Annapoorna is working towards providing these families a monthly (containing grocery kit lentils, wheat flour, cooking oil, and basic spices) salt, sugar every month for the next 1 year.

Ganjam District, Odisha

130 RELIEF KITS DISTRIBUTED IN ODISHA



Ganjam is one of the poor districts lying in the southern part of Odisha. COVID-19 pandemic has pushed people like destitute women, migrant labors, daily wage earners, leprosy patients, rag pickers living in this district to the corner with no or little resources left to them, even for meeting their daily food needs.

In order to alleviate their suffering, Annapoorna volunteers have distributed 130 Grocery kits to the needy people in 6 villages - Dahanipalli, Chirikipada, Kushapalli, Golia, Badua and Mareipalli belonging to Ganjam district this month.

Annapoorna Kalusha Distributed to 50 Families On Independence Day



This Independence Day, Annapoorna Kalusha was distributed to 50 families in Borabanda, Telangana. All of these people are private school teachers and couldn't get their salaries since the last 4 months due to the current pandemic. Out of them, a few are widows. A few of the items distributed were:

Dal (2 kg), Oil (2 L), Sugar (1 kg), Rava (2 kg), Salt (2 kg), Turmeric, Chilli Powder, Mustard, Jeera, Soaps, and Hair Oil.
