MESSAGE BY OUR FOUNDER, SADGURU SRI MADHUSUDAN SAI ON THE LAUNCH OF SAISURE MILLET (RAGI) MULTI NUTRIENT HEALTH MIX IN TELANGANA

SaiSure Fortified Millet (Ragi) Multi Nutrient Health Mix was launched for 25 Lakh (2.5 million) Govt. School Children of Telangana.

Providing nutritious food to everyone is essential. Especially for young children attending schools, this nutritious diet is crucial for their growth.

Recognising this need, the Sri Sathya Sai Annapoorna Trust started the "Morning Nutrition Program" in the year 2012, benefiting 50 children. Over time, the program expanded, and today it covers 30 lakh children (3 million children) across 40,000+ govt schools in 23 states and 5 union territories. The Trust's efforts have been commendable and recognised by various government institutions, societies, and organisations. The program has expanded not only within the country but also in 5 other countries.

Since 2016, the program has covered 10 districts in Telangana state, benefiting around 7 lakh students. Currently, the program will provide morning nutrition to approximately 25 lakh students in around 34,000 schools across Telangana. The joint efforts of the Sri Sathya Sai Annapoorna Trust and the

Telangana Education Department have made this initiative successful. Providing nutritious food has helped various illnesses prevent among children. The program's main objective is to ensure that no child in any government school goes to school hungry ever!

All the school children in Telangana state will now get "SaiSure Millet (Ragi) Multi Nutrient Health Mix," a nutritious health drink prepared with grains, millets, jaggery, and other essential vitamin-mineral mixes. This is prepared in a state-of-the-art nutraceutical facility setup in Sathya Sai Grama, Muddenahalli, Chikkaballapur district of Karnataka. With the approval from PM Poshan Abhiyan Project Approval Board (PAB) and the Department of School Education – Telangana, this programme will be executed with an annual cost estimated at Rs.30 crores. The implementation will be undertaken in joint partnership with Sri Sathya Sai Annapoorna Trust, which will also contribute half of the annual cost.

In all the districts of Telangana, the initiative of providing nutritious food to every government school student is being undertaken with enthusiasm. I applaud all the stakeholders involved in this noble cause.

On this auspicious occasion, I extend my heartfelt congratulations to the trustees, volunteers, vendors, school teachers, students, their parents, and government educational institutions. I extend my best wishes to the Telangana government and the State Education Department on this momentous occasion.

ADDRESS BY THE SECRETARY OF ANNAPOORNA TRUST ON THE BENEFITS OF SAISURE MILLET (RAGI) MULTI NUTRIENT HEALTH MIX

The Annapoorna Morning Nutrition Programme is the largest national-level nutritional intervention programme providing free morning nutrition to over 3 million children attending 40,000 typically rural government schools located across 23 states and 5 Union Territories across India.

Going forward, 2.5 million (or 25 Lakh) students of all government and local body schools across Telangana will be served hot and nutritious 250 ml "Ragi Java" as breakfast every alternate day. This Ragi Malt with Jaggery will be fortified for nutrition and flavoured with other natural ingredients for good taste to make it a wholesome breakfast.

A packet of this health mix contains 1 kg of Ragi millet powder. This is not just any ragi millet powder that you can easily get in stores outside. This is fortified Ragi millet powder. With ingredients like vitamins, mineral mixes, defatted soya, turmeric, salt, and rice flour, this Ragi millet powder is scientifically fortified and manufactured at the SaiSure Nutritions factory.

About 250 metric tonnes of fortified Ragi millet powder will be sent for 25 Lakh (2.5 million) students of Telangana every month. Also, to ensure the breakfast is nutritious, we are sending Jaggery powder and not sugar. If at least 250 ml of Raagi Jaava is given to each student, he or she will not feel hungry for at least 3 hours.

Also, at the back of the Ragi millet powder packet, there is information on the composition of minerals and vitamins in this powder. It has minerals like Sodium, Potassium, Calcium, Phosphorus, Magnesium, Iron, Zinc, Iodine, Selenium, Copper, and Vitamins like vitamin A, vitamin B1, B2, B3, B6, B7, B9, B12, and vitamin C.



With the support from the education minister, Principal Secretary Mrs. Karuna Vakati, and the Director (School Education) of Telangana, Mrs. Sridevasena, we served 7 lakh students in Telangana in the last 7 years. I feel happy today to serve the entire state of Telangana, covering its 25 lakh students, and I thank Mrs. Karuna Vakati and Mrs. Sridevasena for giving us this wonderful opportunity, and we look forward to much more support.



MORNING NUTRITION IN KARNATAKA WITH KELLOGG'S FOR 2023-24

Morning Nutrition was launched by Annapoorna Trust with Kellogg's in Chikkaballapur district of Karnataka & Tirupati district of Andhra Pradesh. SAISURE LAUNCH FOR SAM AND MAM CHILDREN WITH PERSISTENT FOUNDATION

Malnutrition is a severe challenge across the world. Two categories of acute malnutrition are SAM and MAM. SAM (Severely Acute Malnutrition) children are identified by severe wasting, which is defined as low weight for height, and MAM (Moderately Acute Malnutrition) children are identified by moderate wasting. Many nutrition interventions led by the government and various organizations are tackling this huge problem in India.

Sri Sathya Sai Annapoorna Trust, in collaboration with Persistent Foundation, is starting an initiative to provide a nutritional health mix in the form of SaiSure to children who come under the category of SAM and MAM in Chikkaballapur, Chintamani, and Sidlaghatta taluk. Under this initiative, 4 pouches of SaiSure (500 gram each) will be provided to every child over the period of six months from July 2023 to December 2023.

Addressing the gathering, Mr. Nautaj – Child Development Project Officer, spoke about the importance of nutrition for a growing child. DIRECTOR (SCHOOL EDUCATION) OF TELANGANA, MRS. A. SRIDEVASENA, VISITS SAISURE NUTRACEUTICAL FACILITY

An inspection was conducted by the Director of School Education (Telangana state), Mrs. A. Sridevasena, on 19th July 2023, as part of the process, aiming to gain insights into the procurement, preparation, fortification, supply chain management, and logistics planning of finger millet.

During the inspection, the technical aspects were elucidated by showcasing a state-of-the-art nutraceutical facility housed in a 5-storey building, which reflects our unwavering dedication to providing high-quality micro-nutrient health supplements.

Various advanced machinery, thoughtfully placed across different floors, was demonstrated, ensuring a smooth and efficient mixing of ingredients under strictly controlled temperature, humidity, and moisture levels. Additionally, a detailed stocking plan was presented, outlining the organization and management of resources to meet demand effectively.

Furthermore, a special meeting was arranged with the women who work at the facility, emphasizing its significant role in providing livelihood opportunities to many women in the community.

Below is a brief explanation of equipment that is kept on each floor

5th Floor – Infeed Ingredients Section

Infeed ingredients nutraceutical facility refer to the raw materials or ingredients that fed into the facility's are manufacturing process to create finished nutraceutical products such as dietary supplements, functional foods, or functional beverages. These ingredients may include vitamins, minerals, herbs, botanicals, amino acids, and other nutrients, as well as excipients, binders, and fillers used in the manufacturing process.



4th Floor – Sifting & Weighing Section

Sifting and weighing are used to measure and mix precise amounts of ingredients to make medications or chemicals. The process of sifting is used to separate the fine particles from larger ones, ensuring that the final mixture is homogeneous. Weighing, in this context, is used to measure the exact amount of each ingredient to ensure consistent and accurate results.



• 3rd Floor - Blending Section



Blenders are commonly used nutraceutical factories for mixing and blending different ingredients create a homogeneous mixture. These ingredients could include vitamins. minerals, herbal extracts, and other active compounds. The blender is an piece of equipment essential nutraceutical production as it ensures a consistent and accurate mix of ingredients, leading to uniform end product quality. The type of blender used in a nutraceutical factory can vary based on the desired output, the scale of production, and the specific ingredients being blended.

Ribbon blender as well as air vent are part of this setup. Air vent sock helps in maintaining a dust free environment and ribbon blender provides a better homogeneous mixing than the other conventional blenders.

2nd Floor – Metal Detection

A metal detector in a nutraceutical facility is a device used to detect the presence of metal contaminants in food and dietary supplement products. This helps to ensure that the products are free from foreign metallic objects, which could pose a health risk to consumers. The metal detector uses electromagnetic fields or metal-sensing technology to identify the presence of metal, and it is typically integrated into the production line to ensure that contaminated products are rejected before they reach the consumer.



• 2nd Floor - Dehumidifier



This dehumidifier controls the humidity levels. High humidity levels can cause problems such as: encouraging the growth of mould, bacteria, and other microorganisms, which can contaminate the products and affect their quality and safety; damaging the facility's equipment and structures, such as walls, flooring, and ceiling; increasing the risk of corrosion to metal parts and machinery; impairing the air effectiveness conditioning of systems, making it more difficult to optimal temperature maintain humidity levels. By controlling humidity levels, a dehumidifier helps maintain a healthy and safe environment, protects equipment and products, and ensures that the nutraceutical facility operates at peak efficiency.

1st Floor – Divertor

A divertor refers to a device that diverts different separates or ingredients in materials or production line. The purpose of a diverter in a nutraceutical factory is sort or separate different of the production components process, finished products, to ensure correct materials processed and packaged appropriately. The use of a diverter in a nutraceutical factory can improve production efficiency. Segregation of the final product between jars and pouches will be decided at this stage.



Ground Floor – Packaging Area

Packaging materials selection: The appropriate packaging materials are selected based on factors such as product protection, shelf life, and labelling requirements.

Filling and sealing: The packaging material is filled with the nutraceutical product and then sealed to ensure product freshness and integrity. This can be done using various methods, including automatic filling machines, manual filling, and heat sealing.

Labelling and coding: The packaging is labelled with information such as the product name, ingredients, nutrition facts, and expiration date. Some nutraceutical factories also use coding techniques such as bar codes or QR codes for tracking and product traceability.

Quality control and inspection: The packaged nutraceutical products undergo quality control and inspection to ensure that they meet the necessary standards and specifications.

Storage and distribution: The packaged nutraceutical products are stored in a warehouse and then distributed to retailers or directly to customers.



LAUNCH OF MORNING NUTRITION FOR BLIND CHILDREN IN COLLABORATION WITH FAI IN HYDERABAD

On 20th July, Annapoorna Trust started morning nutrition in collaboration with Light a Life – A First American (India) Foundation for 300 blind children at Devnar School for the Blind in Begumpet locality of Hyderabad.

The launch event was held in the presence of Dr. Saibaba Goud and his wife, Mrs. Jyothi Goud, and with Mrs. Padma – a warden, along with the teachers of the school. Mr. Sushanth Karanth – Manager of Corporate Communications, Mr. Dhananjaya Rao Ejapu – Regional Manager of Telangana state, and Mr. Rajesh Patel – Executive operations, were present from Annapoorna Trust.

Devnar School for the Blind is led by Dr. A. Saibaba Goud, who is an ophthalmologist and founder-chairman of the Devnar Foundation for the Blind. A Padma Shri awardee, Dr. Goud, has been honoured with many prestigious awards by six successive presidents of India including Dr. B.C.Roy award, and felicitated by Chief Ministers of states and political leaders. He has authored several books and presented several papers on eye-related subjects. Many paragraphs can be written about a man who has helped the blind lead productive lives, assisted the poor, the sick, and those afflicted with leprosy to live with dignity but all of them can be summed up in a short phrase – the passion to serve the needy.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Goud stressed on the importance of nutrition and the benefits of SaiSure Malt Multi Nutrient health mix which will be provided to the children with milk, on a daily basis. He thanked Annapoorna Trust and Light a Life – A First American (India) Foundation for having come forward to support the needy.

Mr. Sushanth Karanth – Manager of Corporate Communications, Annapoorna Trust, explained to the gathering that every child has the right to good health.





Keeping the needs of every child from economically weaker sections including those of rural and tribal backgrounds in mind, Annapoorna Trust has come up with a nutritious wonder product called SaiSure,' he said. He also dealt in detail how a nutrition intervention like SaiSure Malt Multi Nutrient health mix provided to the growing children every day, takes care of hidden hunger. He went on further elaborating on the nutritional value of this health mix, which is loaded with vital nutrients and micronutrients including Fat-soluble vitamins (Vit. The children individually introduced themselves, and they shared about what they learned in their academics using braille. They also said they read the Braille version of Bhagavad Gita, Ramayana, Biography of freedom fighters like Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel and Swami Vivekananda.





As the event ended, the children were motivated to partake in nutrition-dense SaiSure, and in turn, Annapoorna representatives were motivated by the children as well, for their relentless pursuit of thirst for knowledge despite their shortcomings. Thus, a day was spent very fruitfully with the lovely children.



RESTART OF MORNING NUTRITION PROGRAM IN BANGALORE WITH NARAYANA HEALTH

On 25th July 2023, an official restart of the Morning Nutrition Program in Kengeri, a suburb of Bangalore, took place in the presence of the officials of Narayana Health and Annapoorna Trust. Morning nutrition had already started in these schools at the beginning of July 2023. A total of 1,000 students across 12 schools are benefited in this Bangalore South region. They are provided with cooked breakfasts like upma, avalakki, puliyogare, lemon rice, etc.

Previously, in the year 2022, 360 students received morning nutrition with this intervention. Gradually, the nearby schools showed interest in getting themselves enrolled in this program, which resulted in a greater number of students getting benefited by Annapoorna Trust in collaboration with Narayana Health.



Headquartered in Bangalore, Narayana Health (NH), is associated with the mission of delivering highaffordable healthcare quality, services to the broader population of India. NH, through its CSR policy, aims to make a positive difference in the lives of the people by engaging activities that eliminate alleviates pain and suffering in the underprivileged sections of the society. With a number of programs like H.O.P.E, Suposhan, Mobile Mammography Screening, E-Health Program, NCD Centre program, Udaan, Care Companion Program, and Community Radio Program, NH focuses on striving towards better Health, Education, Environment, and Culture.

The event was held at Ramasandra Government School. With a large, spacious playground, the school is very ambient and provides a serene environment to the children studying there. The official restart of morning nutrition took place in

the presence of Mr. Ankit Shrimali – Head CSR Fund Raising of NH, Mr. Muthuraj – Regional CSR Head of NH Karnataka, Mr. Krishna – Food Consultant and advisor to Narayana Health. Annapoorna Trust was represented by Mr. Ashish Bharadwaj – National CSR Manager, Mr. Vivek Kumar – Social Media Management Manager, Mr. Sushanth Karanth – Corporate Communications Manager, and Mr. Sai Bhaskar – Partner Relationship Manager. The staff of the schools and local community were also

present. Mr. Johnny – SDMC Head, Mr. Rangaswamy – SDMC Coordinator, Mr. Venkatesh – Headmaster of Ramasandra School, and Mrs. Sarojamma – Headmistress of a school in Babusabarapalya, were present. Ms. Nalini from Chikkanahalli and Ms. Sushma from Bhuvaneshwarinagara also participated in the event.

Mr. Venkatesh – Headmaster of Ramasandra school, addressed the gathering by first expressing his gratitude and delight of having started morning nutrition in their school. Explaining that the children hail from poor economic background and their parents majorly being migrant labourers, this daily morning nutrition would immensely benefit them. He thanked Narayana Health and Annapoorna Trust for this noble initiative.

Further, Mr. Sushanth Karnath – Corporate Communications Manager of Annapoorna Trust, spoke to the gathering that Narayana Health, on the one side, is committed to providing quality medical care and excellent patient service, and on the other side, to improving the quality of local communities by providing morning nutrition at Government schools.

Mr. Muthuraj – Regional CSR Head of NH, Karnataka, assured scholarships to needy students. He also notably remarked that this intervention would stop the children from partaking in unhealthy junk food like biscuits, peppermints, snacks, etc, especially in the wee hours.

Without care, society would be impossible. Creating an inclusive society where individuals' needs and concerns are recognized, is the collective responsibility of every individual, community, and government, thereby creating a healthy and happy nation.












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
