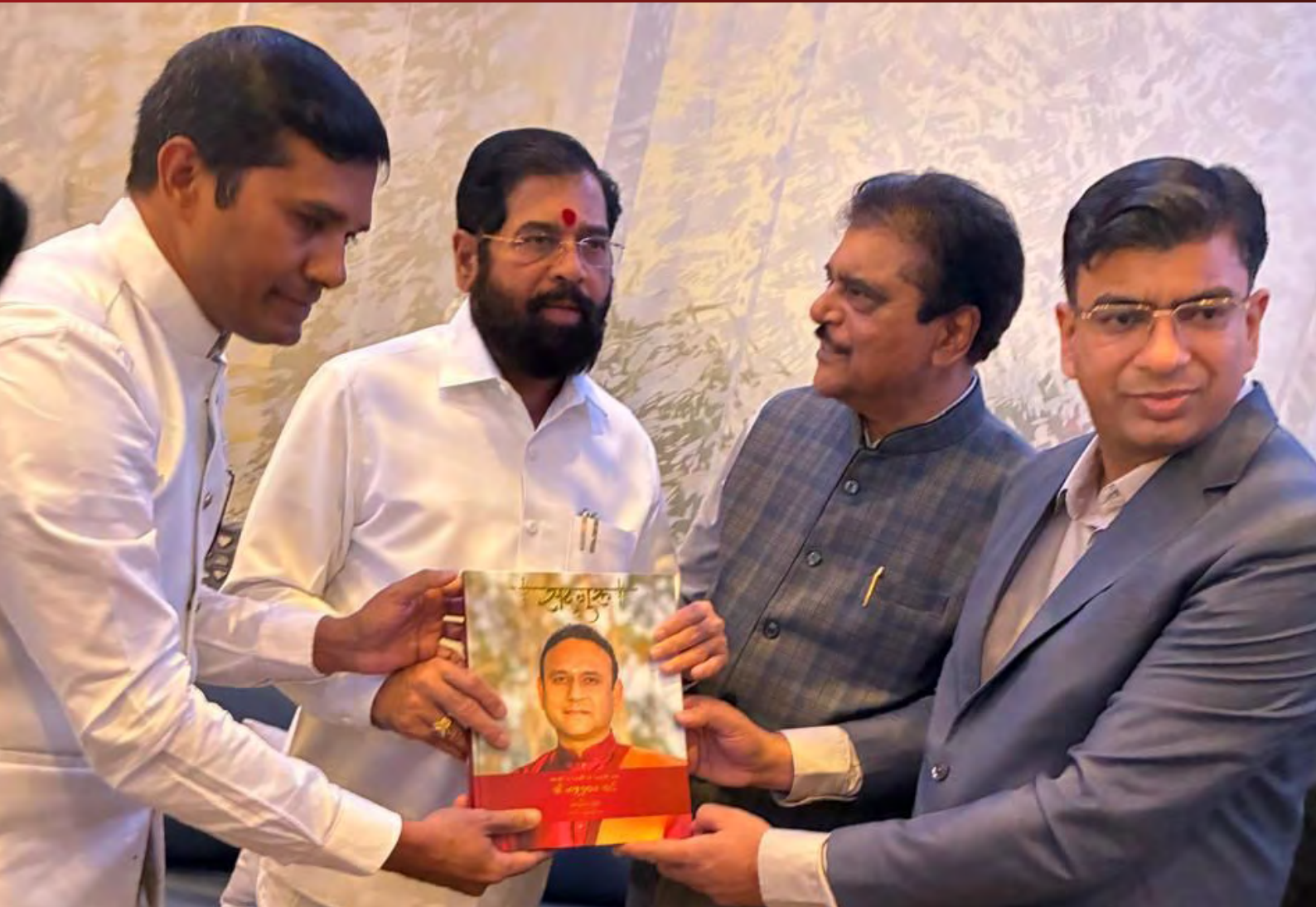

## “Role of CSR in Viksit Bharat Conclave” - From Compliance to Commitment: Repositioning CSR as a Strategic Pillar of Viksit Bharat

# MILESTONE AT ISB HYDERABAD:

## SAISURE MILLET REPORT PRESENTED TO ADVANCE NUTRITION POLICY IN INDIA

A milestone was marked at Indian School of Business, Hyderabad, on 21-03-2026 during the Public Policy Dialogues, advancing nutrition and food systems in India.

Dr. Raj Bhandari, Member of the National Millets Task Force and Advisor to Sri Sathya Sai Annapoorna Trust, presented the NIN SaiSure Millet Report to Arti Ahuja. The submission was made alongside Tara Satyavathi and Deepak Sawant.

The report, developed by the Indian Institute of Millets Research and the National Institute of Nutrition, presents strong evidence supporting SaiSure fortified millet-based (ragi) health mix interventions. It highlights high acceptance among children (3–14 years) across ICDS and school systems, demonstrating their effectiveness as scalable, nutrition-rich solutions to address hidden hunger.

The discussions emphasized integrating millets into ICDS and school nutrition programs as culturally relevant, science-backed approaches to tackling malnutrition. The event also included interactions with J Stanley, CEO of Nutrihub at IIMR, who continues to promote millet-based innovation and startups.

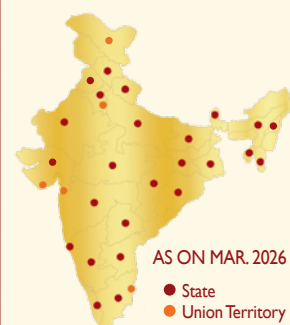

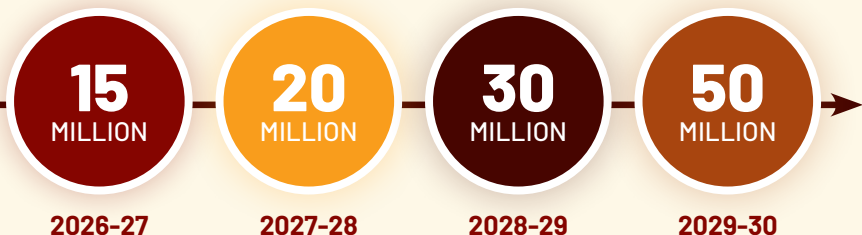
